Helping Active Duty Members Earn Industry Credentials

MSSC is proud to be a part of the Department of Defense Licensing and Credentialing Task Force. Since President Obama's 2012 announcement of the *We Can't Wait* initiative to provide opportunities for up to 126,000 service members and spouses the ability to earn industry-recognized, nationally portable certifications for high-demand manufacturing and logistics jobs.

Through a partnership between Army, Navy, Air Force and Marine Corps, MSSC has completed pilots with each Service for a limited number of service members to achieve credentials that can support a transition from military service to frontline jobs in manufacturing and logistics. Upon completion of each pilot, MSSC reviewed the results with the Service to determine the best course of action to implement the credentials service-wide.

After the pilot phase was completed, the Air Force, Navy and Marines rolled out the program on their respective COOL websites. COOL is the military's Credentialing Opportunities On-Line web portal that connects military personnel to certifications related to their military occupational specialties. All branches of service currently include CLT and CPT on their COOL sites. The Army has expanded their pilot roll out on a national scale.

To date, close to 4,200 military personnel have registered for the program and 4,300 have been issued a certificate. MSSC has established 29 Assessment Centers on military installations and has registered 132 military-friendly centers at community colleges across the country.

In 2015, MSSC introduced the Career Connector, an online registry connecting industry certified Military personnel and Veterans to Transportation, Distribution and Logistics (TDL) Employers. These individuals have 4-20+ years of experience in logistics operations for the military and they have the soft skills (teamwork, discipline, work ethic and sense of mission) that make current and former Military attractive to employers. Now, with CLT certification, they better understand how to apply that experience in the civilian sector.

Many companies want to hire Military and Veterans but often have difficulty identifying those individuals who are interested and qualified for a career in TDL.
